Transition Plan for WCPS

At their September 25, 2020 Meeting, the Wythe County School Board approved a Transition Plan for In-Person Instruction for WCPS. The timeline of the Transition Plan is described in the table below:

In-person Instruction will take place 4 days a week (Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays). **Distance Learning** will still take place for every student every Wednesday.

Students will dismiss at **2:00pm** on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.

Students and families will still be provided a **100% Distance Learning** option. They may choose to transition back to in-person at the mid-term or beginning of each grading period.

Here are the upcoming mid-term and grading period dates:

November 24, 2020 - Mid-term 2nd Quarter Grading Period (Re-enter November 30)

January 15, 2021 - End of 2nd Quarter Grading Period/First Semester (Re-enter January 19)

Wednesdays and 2:00pm dismissals will provide teachers and staff the time necessary to best support our Distance Learning model.
